

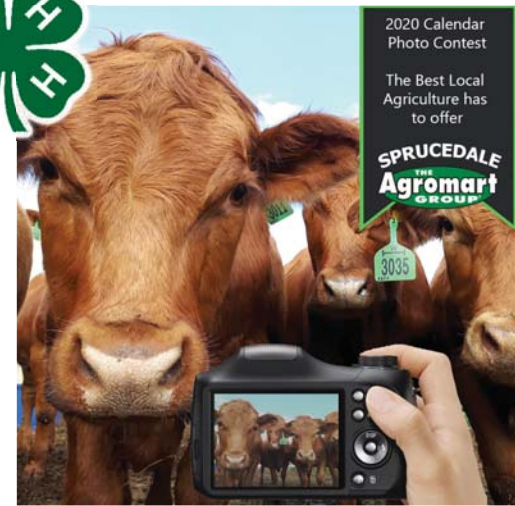

- Enter as many times as you want. However, credit will only be provided for new photos. Photos provided under previous contests will not be considered.
- Deadline to submit photos is midnight on August 31st, 2019
- Photos must be related to the Ontario agriculture industry.
- Watermarks and stock photography will not be accepted.
- Inappropriate content or photography will not be accepted.

- Please DO NOT embed your images in the body of the email. Attach them.
- With approval and proper arrangements, a dropbox/onedrive association may be setup
- Contest only open to residents of Grey and Bruce Counties, & Manitoulin Island.
- A maximum of \$1,000 will be divided between 4-H clubs in Grey & Bruce Counties and Manitoulin Island.
- Photos must be in digital format, and be high resolution (300 DPI) with no Watermarks.
- Each photograph size must be over 1 MB (megabyte) with a maximum photo size of 50 MB (megabytes).
- Photo format must be in jpg, jpeg, png or gif format. These formats are standard for most cellphone photos.
- Photos must be a single work of original material taken by the entrant. By entering the contest, entrant represents, acknowledges, and warrants \ that the submitted photograph is an original work created solely by the entrant, that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trade marks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the photograph.
- To be eligible, please include your contact information as well as that for the 4-H club of your choice
